PREPARING STUDENTS FOR SAFAL PROGRAMME

With the implementation of National Education Policy (NEP), the concept of memorization, popularly known as 'rote-learning' is going redundant. The NEP aims at developing skills in learners to facilitate actual 'learning' (read it as experiencing). The School has been taking steady steps towards its realization. Now we have reached a point wherein our School has been nominated to be a part of SAFAL (Structured Assessment for Analyzing Learning) pilot assessment. Our students of classes V and VIII will be appearing for the same in the month of January. Their performance will testify as to where do we stand as facilitators of 'learning'. In this respect, a teacher training programme was organized by Dr. Harmanjit Kaur Goindi (Coordinator Training, Welfare and Counselling) on 10.12.2022, Saturday. All the teachers teaching Languages, Sciences and Mathematics in classes V to VIII actively participated in the respective training sessions. The major points of discussion were the major hurdles faced by the students and teachers alike in the learning processes and adoption of new methods to enhance inquisitiveness, critical thinking and analytical skills in students.

NATIONAL DEWORMING CAMPAIGN

Albendazole tablets were administered to a total of 1102 students who consented for taking the tablet. The drive began from 1st December to 8th December including the mop up days. It was conducted in two phases: Phase I for students aged 9 and above; and phase II for students aged 6-9. No side effects were reported. The albendazole tablets were provided by Asha workers through the Government of India initiative.

Covid - 19 had tried hard to stop the world. However, due to the right fighting spirit of the Teaching and Parent Community of Sri Aurobindo Public School, the students didn't suffer with continuation of their studies. Sadly, a marked change has been observed in them if we compare their pre-covid and post-covid preferences. Certain pressing issues of concern were taken up during an interactive workshop held in the School campus on 22 & 29 Dec. 2022 by Dr. Tarundeep Kaur, Counsellor and Psychologist, GGSDS College, Sector 32, Chandigarh.

A total of 23 registered parents attended the workshop had their queries lined up for the problem areas of their children in the age group 3 - 9-Year-old. Dr. Tarundeep, in this workshop brought to light the transition of parenting styles and types of families from the past generation to the present generation parents. This has increased the role of parents to teach their children social and mental adjustments as an agenda as compared to these being learnt automatically by the earlier generations. The combined role of teachers and parents was discussed in detail that was readily realized and appreciated by the parents attending the workshop. In session with the Class VI students, Dr. Tarundeep revealed the heavy indulgence of the students in social media and online games. The illegal aspects, mental and psychological effects were discussed with them and the importance of activities at right age/s was emphasized. Besides this a sensitive issue of how to handle pre-adolescent changes was also discussed.

The activities designed were engrossing and thought provoking, even suggesting ways in which the problems faced by parents in rearing their kids.

The session ended on a promising note with the parents asking specific questions with respect to developing habits of self-study, self-discipline, developing social skills in their children. All these questions were effectively catered to by the counsellor, Principal (SAPS), Coordinator (Welfare, Training and Counselling, SAPS) and Coordinator (KG Section).

Career counselling session was held on job prospects by studying Law on 17 December, 2022 Saturday in Aurobindo Hall at School. Ms. Surbhi Thakur, Anijot and Sadhvi presented the presentation.
