## EXPLAINING SCIENCE TO YOUNG MINDS

A Science Fair was held in the school on two days, that is, November 4, 2022 and November 5, 2022. On the first day, a total of 68 exhibits in various aspects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics were displayed and explained by the students of classes VI to VIII. Amid great fervor and excitement, students from all other classes enjoyed the exhibits and interacted actively with all the participants. The day-long event was judged by Mr. Bhagwan Das. A geared model of a bicycle and vacuum cleaner were the star models of the day, duly liked by most of the students. The activity was conducted by the Science Department.

On the second day, the students of classes IX to XII displayed 104 exhibits based on a phenomenon and through various activities demonstrated how that phenomenon is useful in daily life. The students, by way of simple activities, designs, models and charts explained concepts like centrifugal force, p-n junctions, Newton's laws of Motion, Circulation, Surface

tension, remote sensing and many more that have direct and indirect influence on our daily lives. Each stall was a culmination of the applications of a particular concept. The participants were sensitive to the mental age of the students and one could see the level of explanation changing as one proceeded from a 5-year old child to a 14-year old adolescent. The event was inaugurated and judged by the Director, Col. K.S.Randhawa who expressed his admiration for the geniuses in the students.

## TRAINING PROGRAMME ON PREVENTION OF SEXUAL ABUSE & CHILD LABOUR

A training programme on Prevention of Sexual Abuse & Child Labour under (POCSO) was held in St. Jones High school, sector 26 Chandigarh on 16 Nov. 2022. This programme was organised by an NGO Yuvsatta (youth for peace) in close coordination with the State Legal Services Authority, UT Chandigarh, Women & Child Helpline department of Social welfare, Chandigarh administration and Peace club of St. John's High School, Chandigarh. The aim and objective of this workshop was to protect children from sexual assault, abuse and harassment. The programme started with welcoming of the guest speakers by the Principal of the St. Jones school, Ms. Kavita Das. She asserted that child abuse and child labour are the burning topics of today and each one of us have a moral duty to prevent it by reporting the matter to the police on time. A toll free no. of Childline 1098 was shared to report any such matter. Different topics were taken up like good touch, bad touch, confusing touch, types of sexual offences, different sexual behaviours etc. The workshop ended with distribution of participation certificates to the counsellors and teachers.
