Sri Aurobindo's *Concept of Education*

Sri Aurobindo (August 15, 1872- December 5, 1950) was a great patriot, scholar, mystic, philosopher, and yogi. The school has been dedicated in his memory.

Sri Aurobindo has propounded the concept of Integral Education. Therefore, Sri Aurobindo Public School, Baddi (SAPS) is based on his philosophy of holistic education. Education is meant to bring out the best in a child, develop his potentialities to the maximum, and integrate him with himself, his surroundings, his country and humanity so that he becomes a complete man. The more important aspects of an individual are his character, his personality and his values. Therefore, the process of education must be integral.

SAPS Baddi endeavours to groom children to blossom into handsome citizen of developing India. It aims at the all round development of the children in a systematic manner emphasizing physical, intellectual, moral and spiritual aspects of their personality. SAPS aspires to produce good citizens committed to the well-being of our great nation.



Editorial

Sweeping reforms are taking place in the school education. In Fact, the essence of the reforms relate to holistic development of the children through the medium of formal education as has been enunciated by Sri Aurobindo. A Rendezvous with the Principal

The council member of the school grabbed an opportunity for taking interview of The Principal. Dr. Mrs Parminder Duggal, an academican with a single mindedness of purpose and the purpose emanating from empathy for the learner. Dr. Parminder Duggal has brought a turnaround in the school. Here are her responses to our questions.



Q1. Over the last three years the school has achieved heights in all areas of activity. Do you see the school progressing in a satisfactory manner?

School is definitely progressing in satisfactory manner. Over the last years, with the continuous efforts of our staff under the able guidance of Col. PS Choudhry, school has achieved new heights in

academics & other extracurricular activities. The school has launched smart classes where teaching shall be made more effective using ICT technologies. The school has also added one more feather to the already existing achievements by launching its Website making it the only school in this BBND A area to have it.

Q2. What do you think is the toughest call you ever had to make in your job?

The toughest call which I had to make in my job was to enhance the motivation level of teachers after my joining. Presently the staff is in high spirits. As a result school is vibrating with enthusiasm in scholastic & non scholastic areas.

Q3. What is your perception about the class X results?

Class X result has been excellent in past years and shall continue to be the same. I am very proud of our students and teachers. This year with the introduction CCE, students are not having any phobia of board examination and are more relaxed. They have been continuously assessed throughout the year and as a result they shall excel in the exams. I am sure they will do us proud.

Q4. Tell us some experience in school that has really touched your heart and made your job more than worthwhile.

I remember an incident where a grandmother came to the school for admission of her grand child and cited our school as an excellent institution. When ever people come and tell us that the school made a difference, it's an enormous feeling when you feel that you are helping someone lead a better and more fulfilling life.

Q5. When you look back how would you describe the year that has gone by? Where do you see it in next five years?

Last year has been very fruitful and exciting. I see it as a year when SAPS Baddi got ready to take off into the future. The academic block has come up. School after receiving affiliation from CBSE has started class XI (commerce). The third block (science) has come up with the most state of art laboratories. The classes for medical & non medical students have also started from 2011-12. Honorable Chief Minister of Himachal Shri P K Dhumal visited the school last year and appreciated its functioning. Usage of ICT in imparting education was started last year and this year school has implemented full fledged smart classes where technology like Computers, Internet, Multimedia CD shall enhance the learning process. In next 5 years I foresee our school to be the best in the region with its strength reaching around 1500 students. With all the talent I see around me, I am sure our dream will come true.

Q6. With your expertise and experience in the field of education, what strategies would you suggest to the students to combat exam stress?

To be well prepared, it is most important to be regular, be attentive in class, revise and make your own notes because that is when learning takes place. One must find opportunities to learn and not treat it as an imposition. Children reject things that are imposed on them. One must be alert, open and curious, and have a desire to know more. Exams are just part of life.

Q7. To preach about change being the spice of life is easy but to Practice it is difficult. Your comments.

This is very true. If there was no change, we would still be living in caves. It is because of desire for change that we have reached where we are. Any change is difficult to accommodate. One has to accept changes slowly by taking views of all concerned. Accepting changes and implementing them requires taking risks and being a risk taker is an important aspect of a successful person.

Q8. Narrate an anecdote from your school/college day which was truly a learning experience.

There was no such dramatic experience that changed my life forever. Learning has always been a cumulative process. I have learnt a lot of things at different stages of life and with each responsibility I have held.

Q9. The renovations in the school has been received in a positive manner. What are the other changes you plan to incorporate in future?

I propose to initiate building of state of art auditorium in near future .

Q10. How far have you seen yourself growing in last three years?

I have definitely grown as a person in last 3 years. Working as a Principal involves interaction with teachers, students and parents. You have to keep everyone happy and motivated and also ensure proper functioning of the school. This has increased my patience, hardworking ability and maintaining my composure during stressful times.

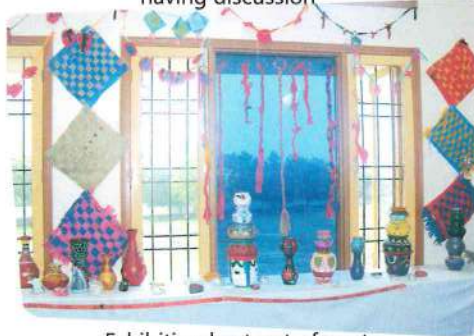

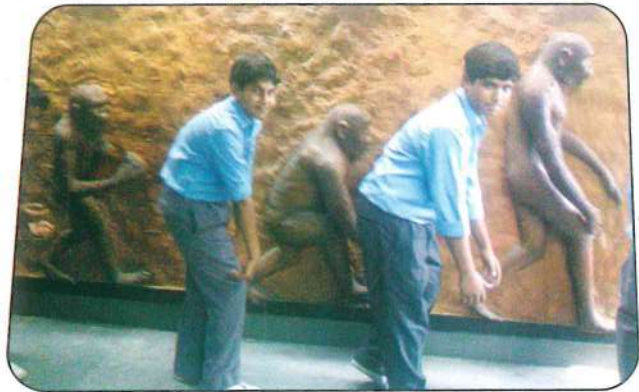

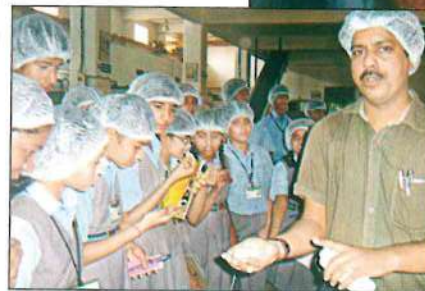

Best Of Luck Party For Class X

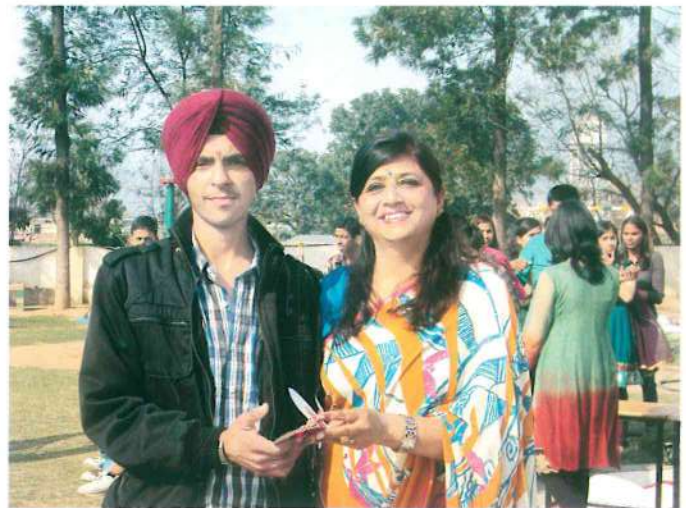


The class IX students organized a best of luck party for the students of class X. The Tilak ceremony was followed by fun filled brain games for the seniors which ended with some light snacks.

Mr. Shubh Karan Singh

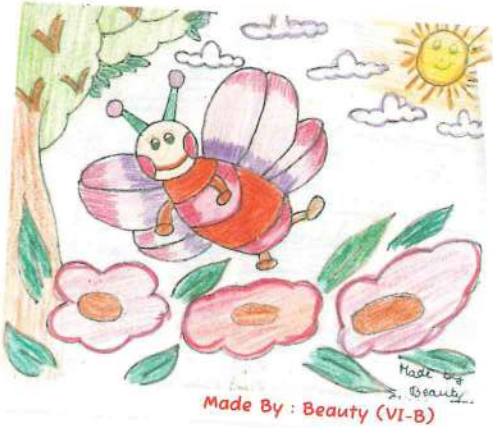
