Padam Bushan awardee Sh S P Oswal (Chairman, Vardhman group of companies) was the chief guest along with Guest of honour, Mrs Shakun Oswal (Trustee). The function commenced with March past comprising of 700 students from the four houses of the school under the leadership of their captains and vice captains. Sh S P Oswal took the salute along with Director Education Col (Retd) P S Choudhry and Principal Dr. Parminder Duggal. After the march past, the school students displayed a beautiful band show on martial tunes. The march past and band display brought out complete coordination between body movement corresponding to varying notes of music. It was followed by grand display of cultural programmes. The programme was enjoyed by parents of all the students and the prominent citizens of BBND. Almost 95% of the students participated in the cultural show. 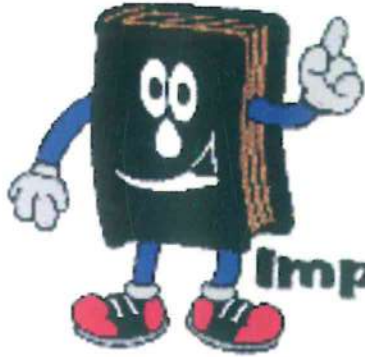






Exhibition and Trade fair

Investiture Ceremony

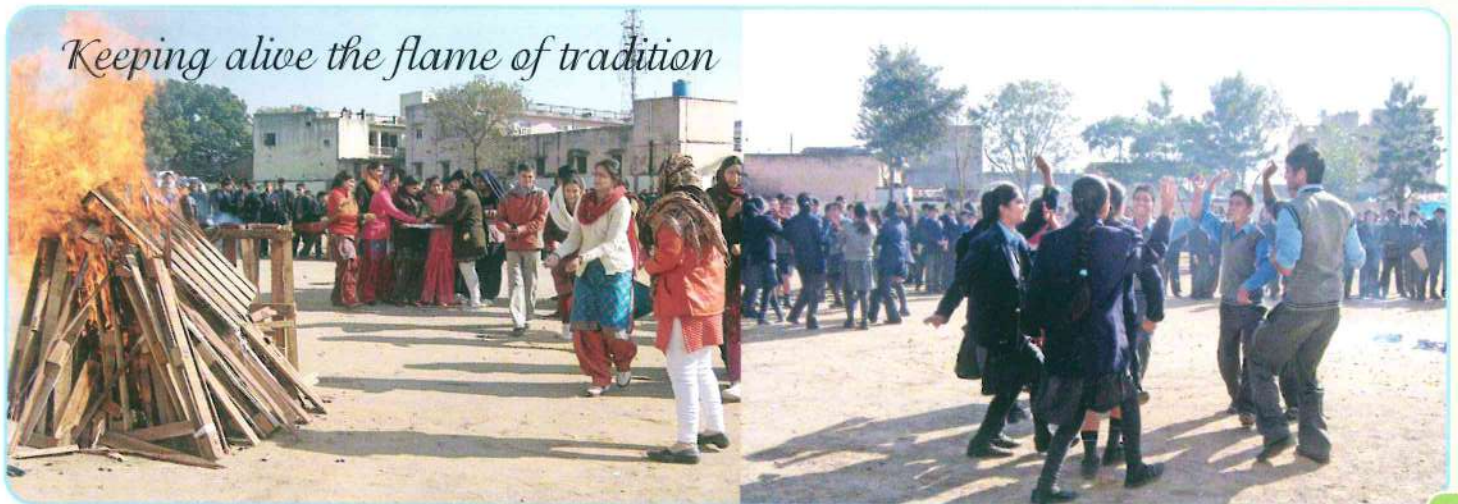

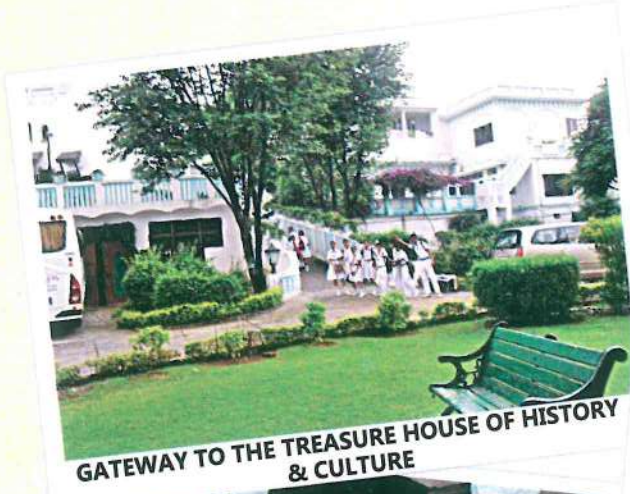
Educational Trips and Tours

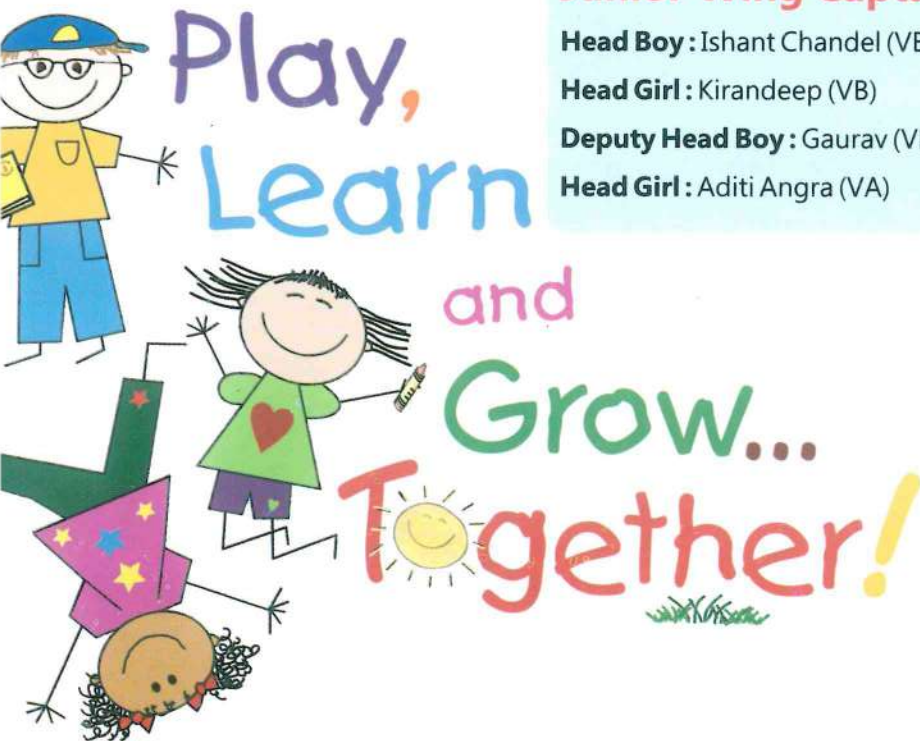

Class X and XII, We are Proud of You"

"There are three ingredients of success: learning, earning and yearning."

The students of Sri Aurobindo Public School have made their mark yet again in the Board Exams held in March, 2012 for classes X & XII. This was the first batch of class XII students and they proved that **'success doesn't come to you, you go to it.'** Out of the 13 students of class XII : Commerce, **Sonal Mittal** became the topper in the BBND Region with 94.2% marks. Three students, Praveen Sharma with 77.6% marks, Rahul Sharma with 77% marks and Shivam with 76.4% marks became the distinction holders and eight students secured the first division.



The result of class X was also exceptional with all the 33 students getting the first division. The students and teachers worked very hard and the result of their labour turned out to be very sweet as four students, **Utkarsh Bajpai, Gaurav Verma, Anika Bassi and Rahul Sharma** scored a **Grade Point of 10** which is a great achievement. 12 students scored A1 grade, 9 students scored A2 grade, 5 students scored B1 and the rest scored B2 grade.

These students have brought laurels to the school and have taken it to dizzying heights.

Appreciation of school's performance and Suggestions by members followed by Vote of Thanks by the Principal : The meeting ended with an applause for the achievements of the school in the previous year. The team work of the teachers, under the able guidance of Col P S Choudhry and Dr. Parminder Duggal, were appreciated. The school has grown from a local brand and this was clearly reflected in the rush for admissions for the new session.

Workshop and Training for Teachers

SAPS is always ready for the changes and equips its teachers to stride forward with confidence and inspire them with a zeal to learn. Director Education and Administration Col PS Choudhry updated the teachers with the new methods for intrinsically motivating students for self-learning. Various workshops were conducted on skills for teaching by the Principal Dr. Parminder Duggal. Continuous discussions and meetings were organized by Mrs Surbhi Thakur - CCE Incharge and coordinator. Workshop on teaching of English was organized by Mrs. Urvashi Sood - HOD English Department. These trainings and workshops acquainted and updated the teachers with the latest and equipped them with new techniques of teaching.

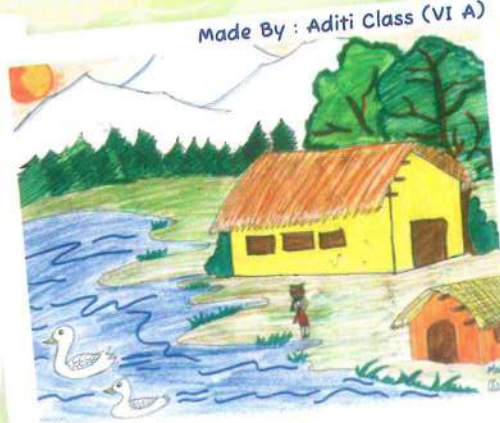
