# THE MOTHER



The Mother was born Mirra Alfassa in Paris on 21 February 1878. A pupil at the Academie Julian, she became an accomplished artist, and also excelled as a pianist and writer. Interested in occultism, she visited Tlemcen, Algeria, in 1905 and 1906 to study with the adept Max Theon and his wife. Her primary interest, however, was spiritual development. In Paris she founded a group of spiritual seekers and gave talks to various groups.

In 1914 the Mother voyaged to Pondicherry to meet Sri Aurobindo, whom she at once recognised as the one who for many years had inwardly guided her spiritual development. After a stay of eleven months she was obliged to return to France due to the outbreak of the First World War. A year later she went to Japan for a period of four years.

In April 1920 the Mother rejoined Sri Aurobindo in Pondicherry. When the Sri Aurobindo Ashram was formed in November 1926, Sri Aurobindo entrusted its full material and spiritual charge to the Mother. Under her guidance, which continued for nearly fifty years, the Ashram grew into a large, many-faceted spiritual community. In 1952 she established Sri Aurobindo International Centre of Education, and in 1968 an international township, Auroville. The Mother left her body on 17 November 1973.

## KG Section Activities

### KINDERGARTEN – THE GREEN HOUSE OF EDUCATION

Kindergarten is truly the green house of education in every sense of the word. The ambience created by transforming these tiny saplings into plants follows the same philosophy of tender loving care used in the green house.

Our students are in the age group of 3 to 5 years acquiring basic skills of recognition, reading, writing and arithmetic. Ages 3 through 5 are wonder years. That's when children begin to learn, to recognise, to reason, to co-operate. Children of this age group have to be taught differently from older ones. Therefore our methods of teaching are designed

to fit the child instead of making the child fit the school. We adopt a combination of Kindergarten as well as Montessori and Play way methods, which make learning fun.

Kindergarten is an important time of transition for young children and is the foundation year upon which future academic success is built. Kindergarten curriculum actually includes individual and group activities in addition to those academic activities.

### ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

The main part of intellectual education is not the acquisition of facts but learning how to make facts live. School conducted its annual Nursery orientation programme to share the basic principles and beliefs of the school with its new parents. The new entrants and their parents were warmly welcomed to the SAPS family.

The event commenced with the Principal Dr. Parminder Duggal briefing the parents about the school's vision of inculcating human values, social responsibilities and environment consciousness in the young buds and also how the little ones should be nurtured with love, care and affection. She emphasized the need to achieve 21st Century

goals of education like learning to know, learning to be, learning to live together and learning to do as the new world is full of challenges. She also highlighted the importance of strong family bonding for the overall healthy growth of the children.

She sufficed the young anxious parents of their queries by giving them useful parenting tips. They admired the role of the school in providing equal opportunity of learning to all the children coming from different strata of society. The event concluded with the parents meeting their ward's facilitators.

PS Choudhry stated that engaging in such kind of activities helps to improve hand eye co-ordination, allows us to hone our creativity, and enables us to develop aesthetic skills. # Science Exhibition

In terms of creativity and innovation, the science exhibition was not far behind. Several working and nonworking models based on syllabus topics were displayed. Some of the exhibits included windmills, Automatic lift, Hydropower crane, dam, Fire extinguisher, automatic garage opener, Security alarm system, Generating electricity from potatoes, Automatic street light, a chemical volcano, an electronic quiz board and an electric bell. The children not only displayed them but were demonstrating their functions and uses to the parent visitors. It was a really good hands on experience for the future scientists to boost up their confidence.



# Computer Exhibition

Our school follows a project based learning methodology, and the students are required to create various projects throughout the year in each subject.

The computer science exhibition showcased their talent by making power point presentations using different templates. The main attraction of this event was the graphic and computer art work of the students, who used Kid pix, drawing software to create the beautiful virtual paintings and drawings.





## Social Science Exhibition

The social science exhibition was divided into three sections to help differentiate between history, Geography and civics. A walk through the history section was equivalent to a walk through time. There were models and charts depicting life right from the stone age to the ages of communication and information technology .

The geography section showcased realistic models of our world. Some of the models showcased the earth's structure

while others focused on the topographical features of our country. Various models like terrace farming were also exhibited.

The civics section of the exhibition revealed charts and models that displayed our student's understanding of the various systems of education and governance. Also of note were charts and posters on themes "Unity in Diversity" and "communal Harmony".

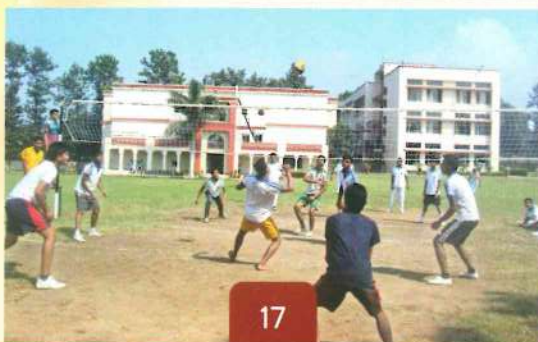

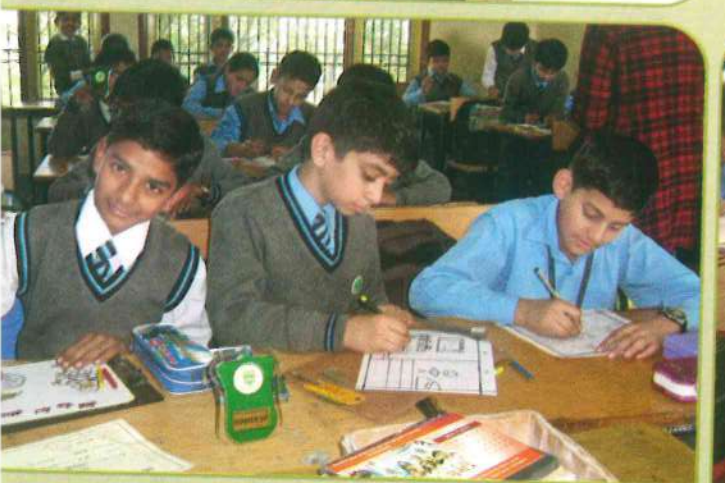
The function was celebrated with an immense gusto and fervor.

That's why I am not always accurate.

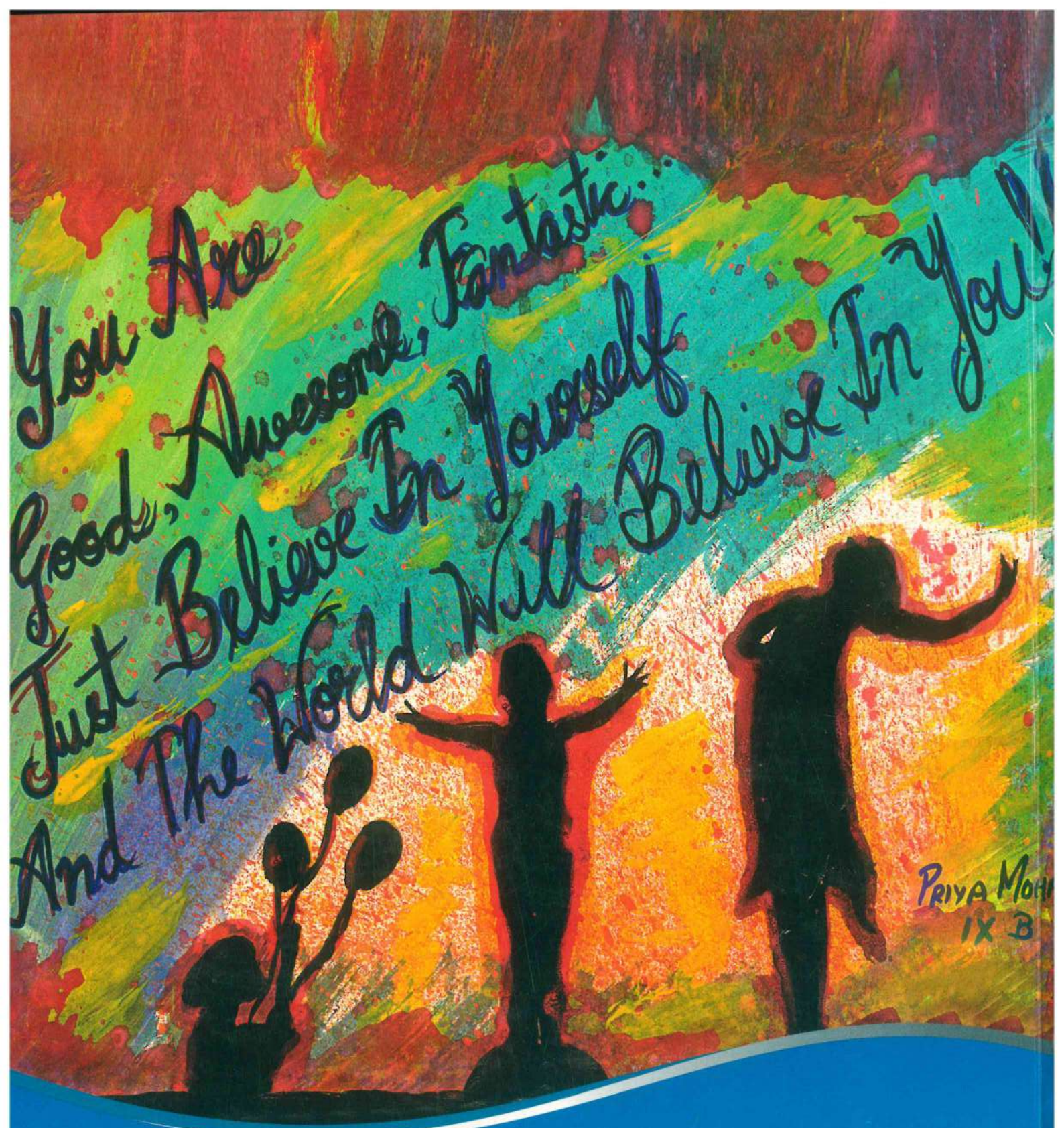
Lastly, please don't forget how quickly I am growing up. It must be difficult for you to keep pace with me, but please try to.
