THE MOTHER



The Mother was born Mirra Alfassa in Paris on 21 February 1878. A pupil at the Academie Julian, she became an accomplished artist, and also excelled as a pianist and writer. Interested in occultism, she visited Tlemcen, Algeria, in 1905 and 1906 to study with the adept Max Theon and his wife. Her primary interest, however, was spiritual development. In Paris she founded a group of spiritual seekers and gave talks to various groups.

In 1914 the Mother voyaged to Pondicherry to meet Sri Aurobindo, whom she at once recognised as the one who for many years had inwardly guided her spiritual development. After a stay of eleven months she was obliged to return to France due to the outbreak of the First World War. A year later she went to Japan for a period of four years.

In April 1920 the Mother rejoined Sri Aurobindo in Pondicherry. When the Sri Aurobindo Ashram was formed in November 1926, Sri Aurobindo entrusted its full material and spiritual charge to the Mother. Under her guidance, which continued for nearly fifty years, the Ashram grew into a large, many-faceted spiritual community. In 1952 she established Sri Aurobindo International Centre of Education, and in 1968 an international township, Auroville. The Mother left her body on 17 November 1973.

We hope that you'll like the new issue."

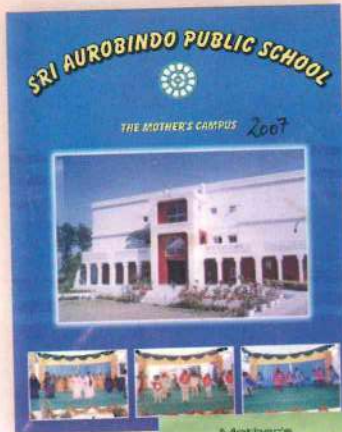

A Rendezvous with our Director ...

Our Director **Col P S Choudhry** was born in Pakistan and had his primary schooling there. A constant urge to serve the nation, propelled him to join the **Indian Army**, where he served for a period of 27 years. He has been writing military publications and has also co-authored some books on logistics. He holds a rich **instructional experience** in army as well, which has stemmed from a number of training programmes that he had been conducting for **Officers of Indian Army and Commonwealth Countries** during his service period. After completing his MBA during his span in the Army, he became a **Fellow of British Institute of Management, U.K.** for 8 years. Designated as the Director Investment and finance, he managed the army funds in a manner beneficial to the Indian Army. This required a high level of honesty and integrity which he displayed to a maximum. He has worked as Head Corporate HR from 1993 to 2003 during which he managed the HR affairs with great expertise. His association with the **Vardhman group** as a **Director education** has also contributed a lot towards the growth of Vardhman's educational institutions from the initial level to the institutes of academic excellence as on date. The **SACCM college of Ludhiana** and **Sri Aurobindo Public School, Baddi** is an example of this. To materialise the Chairman's dream of another institution, he has initiated the setup of **Sri Aurobindo Public School, Budni**. With an aim to learn innovations in teaching pedagogies, he visited **Hull University, U.K, New York University, U.S. and Oxford University, U.K.** from time to time. For the staff members he quotes that *"Whatever you do, it should be for the organization first and for the self second. Integrity and commitment for the organisation you work is a must."*

For the Parents and the Teachers he says *"The values in a child are a reflection of his parents and the teachers. Parents and teachers have to be the role models for the children. A child learns from both of them. So they have to walk hand in hand to foster child's growth."*

Col Choudhry believes that one should contribute to the society as much as he can. He himself has been practicing organized charity with his brother to perpetuate the memory of his elders.

During his free time he enjoys reading, writing and adventure sports. He is a man who practices what he preaches that is why he is a mentor of the teachers and the students at the school. The saga of his untiring urge to excel is unending.

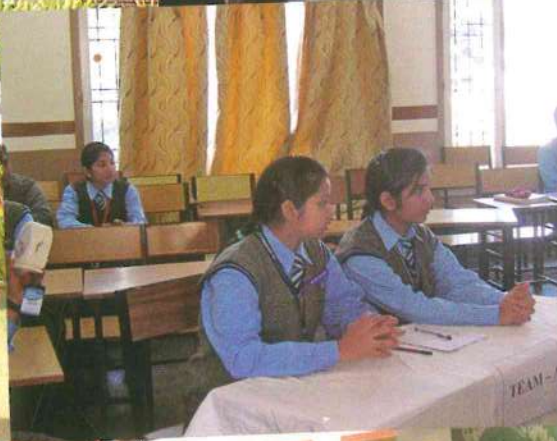
Republic Day

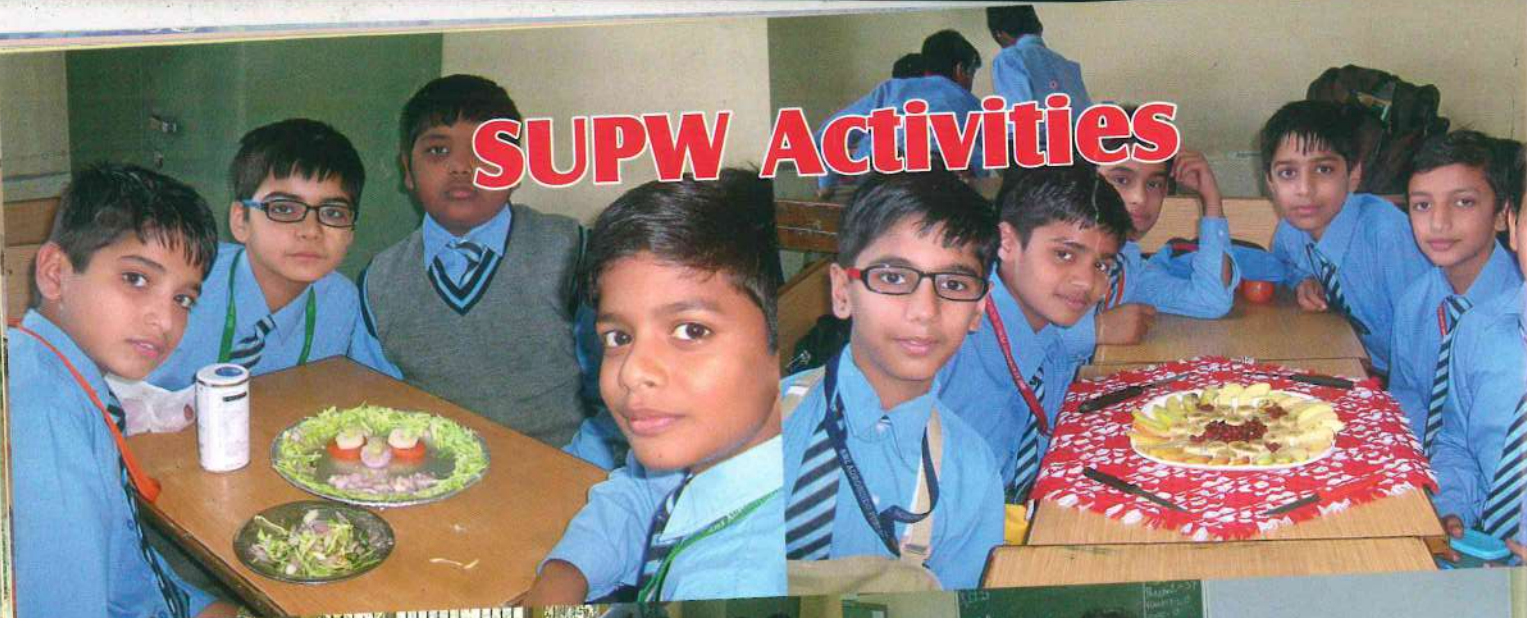

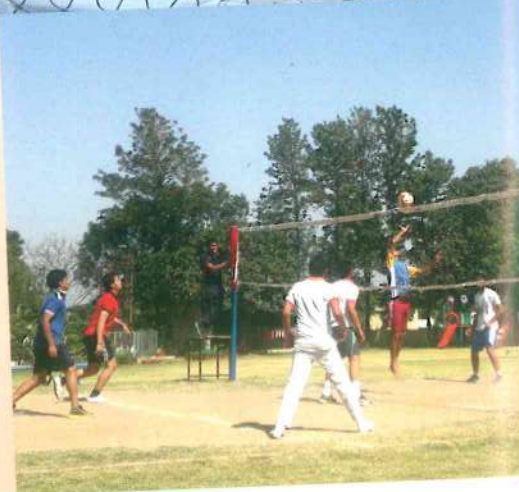

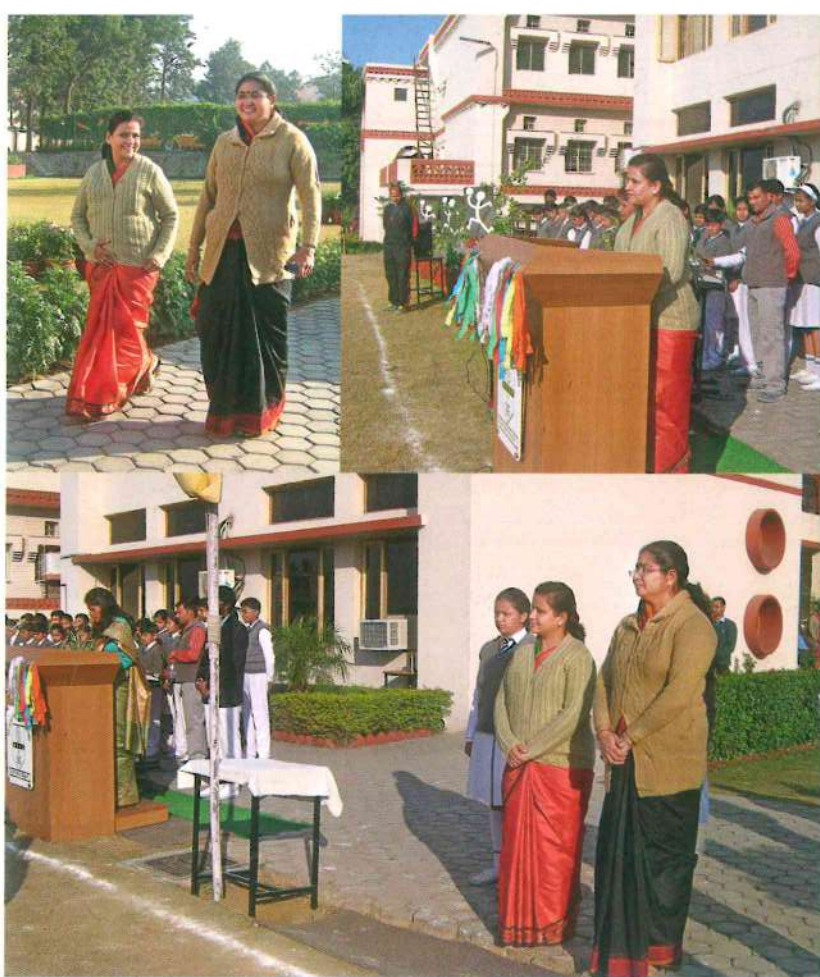
Sports And Athletics

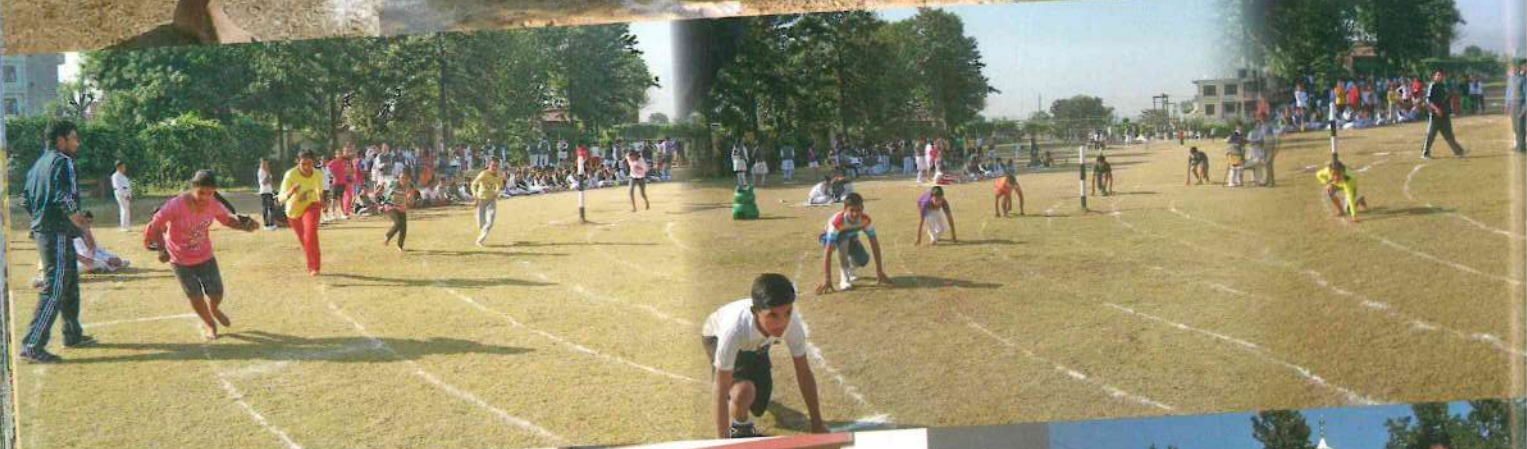
