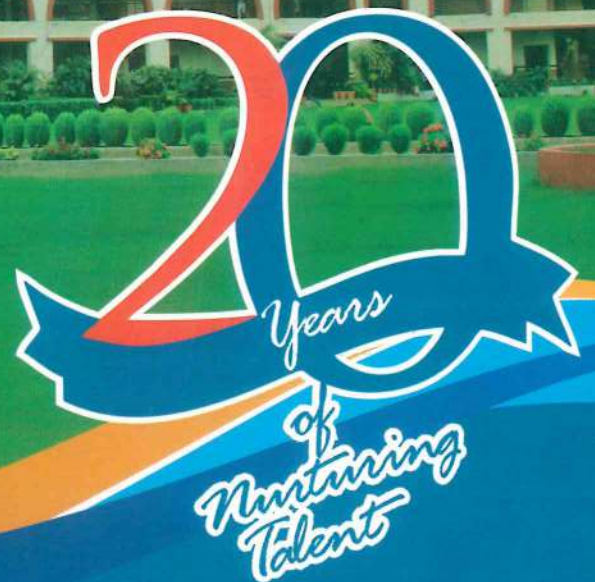

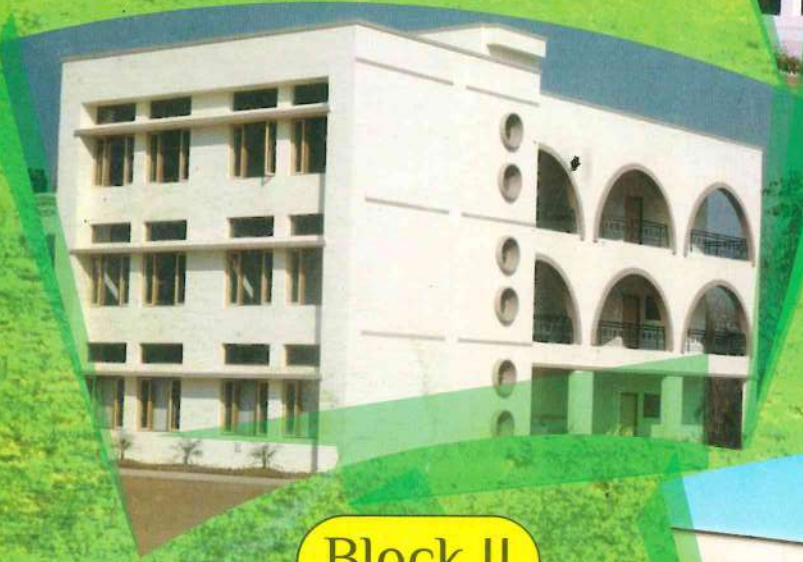

Sri Aurobindo

Sri Aurobindo (Bengali: [Sri Ôrobindo]) (born Aurobindo Ghose; 15 August 1872 – 5 December 1950) was an Indian nationalist, Hindu philosopher, yogi, guru and poet. He joined the Indian movement for independence from British rule, for a while was one of its influential leaders and then became a spiritual reformer, introducing his visions on human progress and spiritual evolution.

Aurobindo studied for the Indian Civil Service at King's College, Cambridge, England. After returning to India he took up various civil service works under the maharaja of the princely state of Baroda and began to involve himself in politics. He was imprisoned by the British for writing articles against British rule in India. He was released when no evidence was provided. During his stay in the jail he had mystical and spiritual experiences, after which he moved to Pondicherry, leaving politics for spiritual work.

During his stay in Pondicherry, Aurobindo developed a method of spiritual practice he called Integral Yoga. The central theme of his vision was the evolution of human life into a life divine. He believed in a spiritual realization that not only liberated man but transformed his nature, enabling a divine life on earth. In 1926, with the help of his spiritual collaborator, Mirra Alfassa (referred to as "The Mother"), he founded the Sri Aurobindo Ashram. He died on 5 December 1950 in Pondicherry.

His main literary works are The Life Divine, which deals with theoretical aspects of Integral Yoga; Synthesis of Yoga, which deals with practical guidance to Integral Yoga; and Savitri: A Legend and a Symbol, an epic poem which refers to a passage in the Mahabharata, where its characters actualize Integral Yoga in their lives. His works also include philosophy, poetry, translations and commentaries on the Vedas, Upanishads and the Bhagavad Gita. He was nominated for the Nobel Prize in Literature in 1943 and for the Nobel Peace Prize in 1950.

This year again, SAPS Baddi has scored 100% success in 10+2 CBSE examination against national average of 83.05%. Our students have made alma mater proud by scoring highest pass percentage successively for the second time since 2014 when its first batch passed out three years back.

Besides it, there are 34 first divisions against 40 students who appeared. Percentage of students scoring more than 80% marks has risen from 7 to 18 against the last year.

Biology students have surprised all by scoring 90% or higher marks by pitching 10 positions out of total 14 students who had opted for the subject. On behalf of management of the school, I heartily congratulate all students on their commendable performance. My highest appreciation is for the Principal and the teachers of the school who had put in extreme hard work to improve quality of teaching which has enabled the students to maintain high academic tradition.

In the area of holistic development, enhancement of mental ability capacities and levels of our students have made incredible strides. In the untraditional activities like Abacus and Olympiads, our students have astonishingly touched new

horizons. Not only participation has increased, students have proved that they are no less than wonder children. In Abacus, which enables a child to do fast calculations with full concentration and total focus, one of our students, Arpita Panigrahi, has recorded history by having been declared champion at national level. Same student stunned all by getting international rank 1 in Maths Olympiad. There are other students also who got cluster to national level awards in Olympiads pertaining to other subjects. The Principal and two teachers received citations, a trophy each and cash awards for guiding students in putting their best foot forward in Olympiads.

The best achievement of the year was the gift of that part of infrastructure which is necessary for use by students for academics and extra curricular activities. Students shall now have full complement of class-rooms with smart class facilities (17 smart class rooms) a state of the art computer lab, a Biology lab and a multi-purpose hall. Plan for a 200 meter running track has already been approved for implementation in the next two months.

With complete academic and holistic development wherewithal, I wish great success to all students for the session 2016-17.
