



#### The beautiful things about learning is that no one can take it away from you.

Every year, the school has tradition of producing not only 100% class X & XII results but also of show casing 75 to 80% of students scoring first division marks or above upto 95%. From class XII, in the last two years, there have been three to five students who succeeded in joining national level institutes in the Engineering, Medical & Commerce.

It is all because of collective efforts of our hardworking and bright students and parents who have been helpful to their wards and co-operative to the school leadership and our committed teachers.

Good results and desired discipline as expected has been a source of inspiration to the school management. On their behalf, they have always made efforts which result in enhancement of quality education and holistic development of students.

For the last one year, we have put in sustained efforts to develop sports culture so that children remain always fit. By allocating one period every day for all students, we ensured that every student walks out of the class room and gets engaged in some sports activity. Also, it is compulsory for KG classes, class I & II students. They normally do not play any organized game but attend Kooh games which are run by a specialists. Compulsory playing of games has created a passion for some of the students. Such Students visit the school one hour before the assembly for special coaching by a qualified coach. Most of such players

have shown preference for Volleyball and Athletics. The evening coaching is also available in the school.

In academics, we have started evening classes to teach Mental Maths besides Abacus which is already being taught for the last many years. Computer Lab which is air conditioned is equipped with all desired tools for preparing children for online practice. Recently, English Teaching Lab has been introduced.

From the current year, mentoring of potential students and less experienced teachers has been undertaken. Students who normally produce good results at school level are developed into aiming big so that they can achieve board level distinctive positions. Similarly, teachers who need improvement into delivery of academic content are counselled to ensure desired learning outcomes.

On the whole, we offer our students a stress free learning environment which encourages application, creativity and critical thinking.

I must appreciate and thank parents of our children who have always been very cooperative to our ideas and suggestions.

We are determined to achieve a system where learning is a matter of joy, the stress and pressure of achieving marks and grades is replaced by the joy and pleasure of attaining knowledge which the child can apply to solve real life problems.

An individual is incomplete until he makes himself useful for the society. To imbibe qualities of empathy and sharing, the school has initiated the community service programme. Last year the major event was collecting usables and distributing it through an authorized NGO. In the current year, SEWA club has been formed to further the cause of 'sharing and caring'. At present the Club conducts awareness activities within the campus, which we wish and hope will extend beyond the walls to further a great cause.


#### Teacher's Day Celebration








#### Republic Day













































































































## Thematic Assemblies


Thematic assemblies play an important role in building student's confidence for public speaking. The topics taken for thematic assemblies give them complete knowledge about topics like important days, Important
