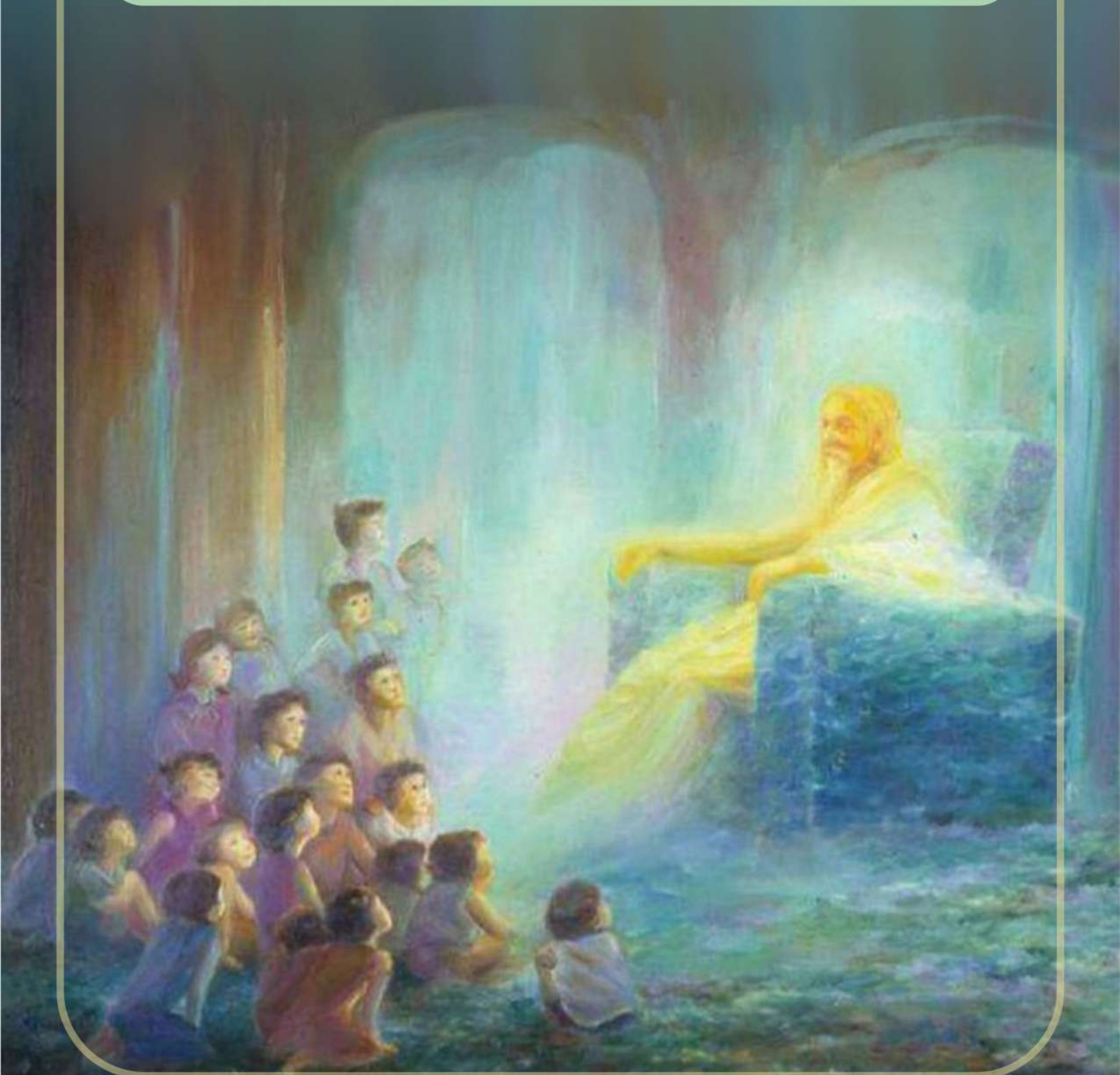

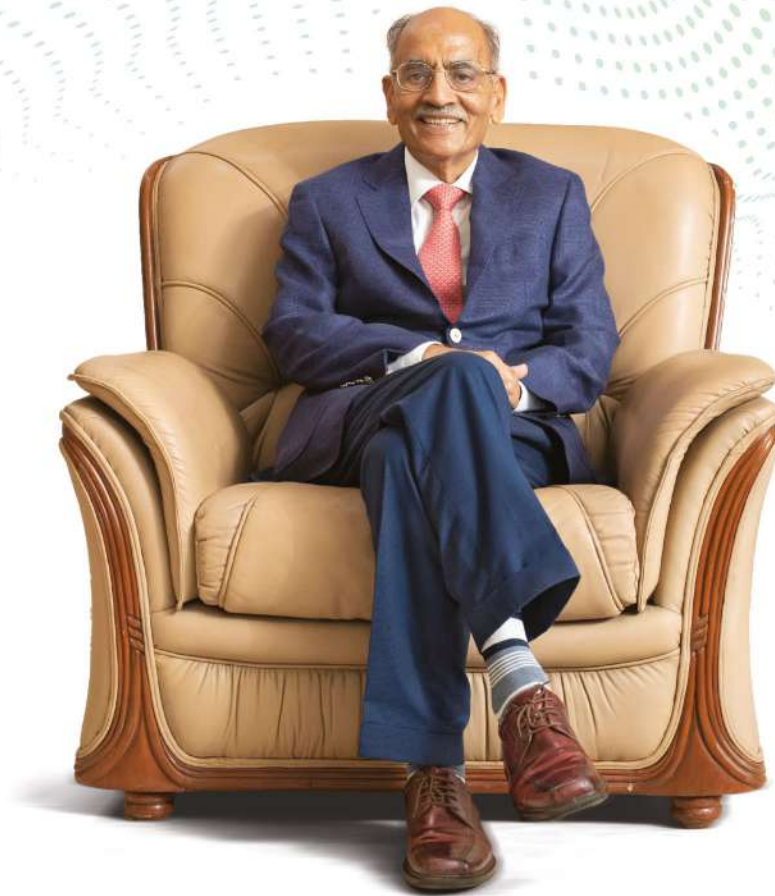

S. P. Oswal was born in 1942, in Punjab. He is a postgraduate in Commerce from Punjab University which he passed with Gold Medal. In the eighties, He joined his family business group, Vardhman Group of Companies. He presently heads the group.

He is reported to have contributed to strengthening the spinning industry in North India. He is also regarded as the force behind the establishment of the Ludhiana Stock Exchange in 1983. Apart from leading the Vardhman Group into a position of prominence in the Indian business milieu,

He was also involved in many socially relevant initiatives.

Inspired by the teachings of Aurobindo, S. P. Oswal established a trust, in Ludhiana, by name, Sri

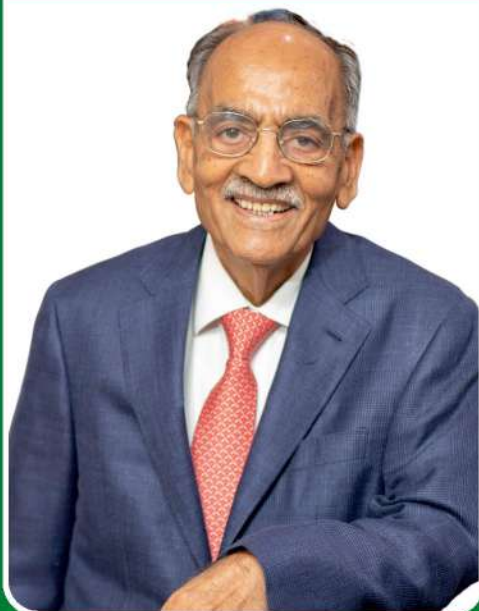

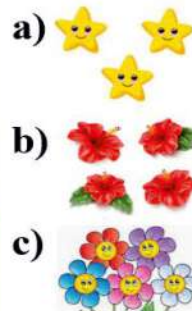
In the current session 2023-24, we have printed our first work-book in Nursery session and it is currently under the revision process. Special features of this book are that children will learn
