SCHOOL REOPENING & TEACHER TRAINING

SAPIANS SHINE IN CBSE BOARD EXAM CLASS XII RESULTS

The CBSE board exam results were declared on July 22, 2022 for both the classes, X and XII.

Medha Mishra of XII Science scored 97.2% and became the District Topper.

Harshita became the school topper in XII Humanities by scoring 94% and Divyansh Goel became the school topper in Commerce Stream with a score of 94%.

In Biology, Medha scored 99 marks.


