INITIATIVES BY SAPS-THE BHARAT SCOUTS & GUIDES, HIMACHAL PRADESH

An Inter school Business Cohort was organised by Shemrock School, Mohali on 11&12 October 2022. Various competitions like Business quiz, Debate and Advertisement making competitions were organized. Around 18 schools participated in this competition that lasted for 5 hours. It was a 3 round competition which covered the questions related to business history, personalities, logos, punchline, tagline, brand ambassadors, current affairs, stock market, investors, etc. There were 2 participants in each teams. Our students got exposure to various kinds of activities and got motivated to upgrade their knowledge and skill to compete with other schools.

SAPS EXCELS IN CHILDREN SCIENCE CONGRESS









The HP State Council for Science, Technology & Environment (HPSCST&E) is promoting the scientific and technological innovations among the school children in the State so as to bring out the hidden talent in the young minds. It provides forum for the children between 10-17 years of age to undertake study in their locality by applying the methods of science under the prescribed theme. The outcome of the study is presented through project reports along with

posters at different levels of CSC. In this programme, emphasis is laid on learning by doing and on field projects to be undertaken by children under the guidance of teachers. The programme has been successful in creating interest in science among students & teachers. Up to District level, the programme is organized by the Department of Education, through Deputy Director (Education), Science Supervisors/Science consultants as per the programme guidelines. However, the students are selected for National Level CSC at State Level Science Congress.

Children Science Congress was organised at sub division level at GSS School Brotiwala on 17, 18 October 2022 where our students participated under all the three categories (Junior, Senior and Senior Secondary) for Science Activity corner, Quiz, Maths Olympiad, Innovative Model and they preformed very well. We also received prizes for Quiz, Innovative Model and Math Olympiad.

- First Prize in Innovative Model
- Second Prize in Quiz in junior category
- Third Prize in Quiz senior secondary category

Giving exposure and Participation in the scientific activities enhances the scientific skills of the students and gives them exposure to think critically and find out solutions to their day to day problems.

SCHOOL INNOVATION COUNCIL AT SAPS BADDI



CBSE in collaboration with the Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell and AICTE (All India Council for Technical Education) invited schools for training teachers as Innovation Ambassadors' starting from the third week of May 2021 under the Innovation Ambassador Program'. Under the Program, the teachers were to be trained on the following four modules:

- 1. Design Thinking & Innovation
- 2. Idea generation & Ideal hand-holding
- 3. Intellectual Property Rights
- 4. Product/Prototype development

Through the 'InnovationAmbassador Program' CBSE had envisaged to train 50,000 teachers from all CBSE schools as 'InnovationAmbassadors'. This Program was offered free-of-cost to all CBSE schools.

Launch of the Innovation Ambassador Program was scheduled on 13th May 2021. The first batch of the first module of the program, Design Thinking & Innovation started from May 17, 2021.

SAPS registered 5 teachers for the programme. All five teachers including the Principal (SPOC for the training) have successfully completed 72-hour training and certified Innovation Ambassadors after online evaluation. This has led to the establishment of School Innovation Council in the School. The School will now be able to access the activities conducted by AICTE, including various




Hackathons. The teachers who are trained as Ambassoders will be able to help students in design thinking, idea generation and if found appropriate for applying for patents.

INTERHOUSE RANGOLI COMPETITION
















