A training programme for school leaders at Indian Institute of Ahmedabad on 'Strategic Leadership for Schools in a Changing Environment' was attended by Principal, Mrs. Anila Nair from June 19 -23, 2023. The programme was meant for Principals or promoters of Senior Secondary Schools. It focused on the multiple roles and responsibilities of the school principal, provide space to examine issues that most principals face today and facilitate evolving strategic responses for better future of the school. The programme aimed at strategic management for

a progressive school climate, decision making, developing positive social - emotional climate in schools, school discipline through restorative practices, helping students with emotional regulation, team building, mindful leadership, managing evaluation and feedback for teachers and staff and managing innovations in school. The training was attended by a batch of 62 school leaders from different parts of the country. It is 23rd in the series of Executive Education Programmes for school leaders conducted by Ravi J Matthai Centre for Educational Innovation (RJMCEI) at IIM Ahmedabad.

IDEATION, DESIGN AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP BOOTCAMP

Ministry of Education in association with All India Council of Technical Education had organized its first ever 5 day physical contact Bootcamp for School Students, School Teachers, College Students and College Teachers at six different locations across India. The onus lied with Wadhvani Enterprises who planned and provided the resource persons in collaboration with Mr. Abhishek Ranjan, the key organizer from the Innovation Cell, Ministry of Education.

Our team of Navpreet Singh Saini (XII, Commerce), Abhinav Sharma (XII Non - Medical Sciences) and Dr. Harmanjit Kaur Goindi (Coordinator, Welfare, Training and Counselling) was selected for the Camp held at NITTTR, Chandigarh. A total of teams from 14 states across the nation were selected, ours being the only one from the state of Himachal Pradesh. The Bootcamp was inaugurated by Education Minister, India, respected Mr. Dharmendra Pradhan virtually on 22.6.2023. A total of 20 sessions (schedule attached) were attended encompassing the entire journey from design thinking to product/service/system formulation finally to enter the market. They were all interactive in nature and some of them gave an opportunity to the participants to interact with CEOs of new start ups like Surya Enviro and Surya Chemicals, PayTM, Terafac Technologies, Buy Lowcal and 99beagles.



The last two days selected teams of school and college students had to pitch for their ideas to a panel of experts. The results of the same were announced and the winners were awarded during the closing ceremony by Director, NITTTR.



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
