



We are immensely happy to bring this issue of the news letter in the form of magazine "MOTHER'S CAMPUS" highlighting the activities of the school in the session 2011-12.





The physical education provides opportunities to participate in various competitions inside the campus and also at the interschool level.








# Street plays


# Educational Trips and Tours






## PAREMELL & BEST OF LUCK The Sapians way





#### Class X and XII, We are Proud of You"

The students of Sri Aurobindo Public School have made their mark yet again in the Board Exams held in March, 2012 for classes X & XII. This was the first batch of class XII students and they proved that 'success doesn't come to you, you go to it.' Out of the 13 students of class XII: Commerce, Sonal Mittal became the topper in the BBNDA Region with 94.2% marks. Three students, Praveen Sharma with 77.6% marks, Rahul Sharma with 77% marks and Shivam with 76.4% marks became the distinction holders and eight students secured the first division.



The result of class X was also exceptional with all the 33 students getting the first division. The students and teachers worked very hard and the result of their labour turned out to be very sweet as four students, **Utkarsh Bajpai, Gaurav Verma, Anika Bassi and Rahul Sharma scored a Grade Point of 10** which is a great achievement. 12 students scored A1 grade, 9 students scored A2 grade, 5 students scored B1 and the rest scored B2 grade.

These students have brought laurels to the school and have taken it to dizzying heights.

Workshop on teaching of English was organized by Mrs. Urvashi Sood - HOD English Department. These trainings and workshops aquainted and updated the teachers with the latest and equipped them with new techniques of teaching.
